I. KANSAS CITY RECORDS CENTER, MISSOURI. *Effective 1 October 1960*, the Kansas City Records Center, Missouri, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant General, is discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.

II. U.S. ARMY TRANSPORTATION COMPTROLLER FIELD SERVICE OFFICE, FORT GEORGE G. MEADE, MARYLAND. *Effective 28 September 1960*, the U.S. Army Transportation Comptroller Field Service Office, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Transportation, is relocated from the Brooklyn Army Terminal, New York, to Fort George G. Meade, Maryland a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second United States Army.
