1. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Element, Military Assistance Advisory Group, Republic of China, Taiwan, is designated by the Secretary of the Army pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial effective 1 December 1960.

- 2. Effective 1 January 1961, the Chief, Counter Intelligence Corps is redesignated the Chief, Intelligence Corps, U.S. Army.
- 3. The Intelligence Corps, U.S. Army, will include all personnel assigned designated primary MOS's in the following intelligence functions:
 - a. Counter intelligence.
 - b. Field operations intelligence.
