I..OFFICE OF ORDNANCE RESEARCH, DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA.

Effective 16 January 1961, the Office of Ordnance Research, Durham, North Carolina, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is redesignated the U.S. Army Research Office and reassigned as a class II activity under the command of the Chief of Research and Development, U.S. Army.

II..U.S. ARMY SIGNAL UNIT SURVEY TEAM, FORT GEORGE G. MEADE, MARYLAND. Effective 7 February 1961, the U.S. Army Signal Unit Survey Team, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, located at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland, is discontinued.
