I. ORDNANCE ARCTIC TEST ACTIVITY, FORT WAINWRIGHT, ALASKA.
Effective 1 April 1961, the Ordnance Arctic Test Activity is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of The Chief of Ordnance, at Fort Wainwright, Alaska. The Ordnance Arctic Test Activity is attached to the Yukon Command for logistical support and certain administrative support as mutually agreed to between representatives of the Chief of Ordnance and the Commanding General, Yukon Command.
