**I..THE UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING CENTER, FORT POLK, LOUISIANA.** *Effective 25 August 1961*, the United States Army Training Center, Fort Polk, Louisiana, is established as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fourth United States Army.

**II..THE UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING CENTER, FORT GORDON, GEORGIA.** *Effective 31 August 1961*, the United States Army Training Center, Fort Gordon, Georgia, is established as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third United States Army.

**III..INDIANA ARSENAL, INDIANA.** *Effective 23 August 1961*, the Indiana Arsenal, Charleston, Indiana, a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is placed in an active status.

**IV..NORTH DEPOT ACTIVITY, NEW YORK.** *Effective 1 January 1962*, the North Depot Activity, New York, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, located at the Seneca Ordnance Depot, New York, is combined and consolidated with the Seneca Ordnance Depot, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.

**V..U.S. ARMY ELEMENT, AIR FORCE MISSILE TEST CENTER.** The U.S. Army Element, Air Force Missile Test Center is hereby designated a class II activity under the command of the Chief of Research and Development. Designation, organization, mission and table of distribution number remain unchanged.
