**HEADQUARTERS,

WASHINGTON 25, D.C., 20 September 1961**

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I. UNITED STATES ARMY ELEMENT, DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY (0843), WASHINGTON 25, D.C. Effective 1 October 1961, the U.S. Army Element, Defense Intelligence Agency (0843), is organized with station in Washington, D.C. Table of distribution number 80-0843 is assigned to this activity.

II. LOUISIANA ORDNANCE PLANT, SHREVEPORT, LOUISIANA. Effective 14 September 1961, Louisiana Ordnance Plant, Shreveport, Louisiana, a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is placed in an active status.

III. NEWPORT CHEMICAL PLANT, INDIANA. Effective 20 April 1961, the Newport Chemical Plant was established and activated as a class II industrial activity, under the jurisdiction of the Chief Chemical Officer, at the Wabash River Ordnance Works, Indiana, a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.

IV. FORT CHAFFEE, ARKANSAS. Effective 19 September 1961, Fort Chaffee, Arkansas, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fourth United States Army, is placed in an active status.

V. THE UNITED STATES ARMY TRAINING CENTER, FORT CHAFFEE, ARKANSAS. 1. Effective 10 September 1961, the United States Army Training Center, Fort Chaffee, Arkansas, is established as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fourth United States Army.

2. Section 1, General Orders, 20, 7 September 1961, is rescinded.

VI. THE UNITED STATES ARMY RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF ENVIRONMENTAL MEDICINE (08.3405.12). Effective 1 July 1961, the United States Army Research Institute of Environmental Medicine (08.3405.12) is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, at the Quartermaster Research and Engineering Center, Natick, Massachusetts, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General.
