INTERIM CONTINUANCE OF OFFICERS

AND FUNCTIONS

- 1. Reference: Reorganization Order issued by the Secretary of Defense on 10 January 1962. Pursuant to subsection 202(c), National Security Act of 1947, as amended (72 Stat. 514; 5 U.S.C. 171a(c)), the Reorganization Order will be effective 2400 hours, 16 February 1962, or such later date as is determined under the provisions of that subsection.
- 2. Effective 0001 hours on the day following the effective date of the Reorganization Order, the following offices are hereby established:
 - a. Chief Signal Officer;
 - b. Adjutant General;
 - c. Quartermaster General;
 - d. Chief of Finance;
 - e. Chief of Ordnance;
 - f. Chief Chemical Officer;
 - g. Chief of Transportation.
- 3. Pending further order, the established offices will have the same duties, functions, and responsibilities as those now constituted and present incumbents will continue to serve in their respective capacities. The Chief of Engineers will continue to perform the functions transferred to the Secretary of the Army by Section 2 of the aforesaid Reorganization Order.
