- I\_OFFICE OF THE CHIEF OF CIVIL AFFAIRS. Effective 1 May 1962, the Office of the Chief of Civil Affairs is discontinued and all of its assigned functions, personnel, funds, files, facilities, and equipment transferred to the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations.
- II-DIRECTOR OF ARMY PROGRAMS. 1. Effective 1 May 1962, the Office of the Director of Army Programs is established in the Office of the Chief of Staff.
- 2. Effective the same date, the Office of the Chief, Programs and Analysis Group, Office of the Chief of Staff, is discontinued and all of its assigned functions, personnel, funds, files, facilities, and equipment transferred to the Office of the Director of Army Programs.
- 3. The Director of Army Programs is the principal assistant to the Chief of Staff and Vice Chief of Staff on all matters relating to Army programing and takes action for them on programing and reprograming matters not requiring their personal attention. He coordinates preparation of material to be used by the Secretary of the Army and the Chief of Staff in appearances before Congressional committees; serves as Chairman of the Program Advisory Committee; serves as a nonvoting member of the Budget Advisory Committee; and provides Army staff point of contact with the Office of the Special Assistant for Programs and Budget, Joint Staff.
- III\_THE INSTITUTE OF HERALDRY, U.S. ARMY. Effective 1 May 1962, the Institute of Heraldry, U.S. Army, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General, is transferred to and redesignated as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant General.
