- 2. Paragraph 3, GO 32, 1956, subject: "Responsibility for Civilian Personnel Management in the Army Establishment", as amended, is further amended by adding subparagraph l as follows:
 - "l. The Commanding General, U.S. Army Combat Developments Command, for the activities under his command."
