I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Supply and Maintenance Command, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 1 August 1962*.

II. DCSLOG DATA PROCESSING CENTER. 1. *Effective 15 May 1962*, the DCSLOG Data Processing Center, Washington 25, D.C., is organized and established as a class II activity under the command of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics with stations at Radford, Virginia, and Washington 25, D.C.

2. Table of Distribution 86-9800 is assigned to this activity.

3. The mission of this activity is to perform during peacetime and mobilization, the data processing mission as prescribed by the Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics.

4. Section II, DA General Orders 23, 1962, is rescinded.
