I--U.S. ARMY INTELLIGENCE CENTER. *Effective 1 July 1962,* the U.S. Army Intelligence Center, a class II activity under the Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence, is redesignated as the U.S. Army Intelligence Corps Agency.

II--U.S. ARMY INTELLIGENCE CENTER. *Effective 1 July 1962,* the U.S. Army Intelligence Center is established at Fort Holabird as a class I activity, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second United States Army.
