II. UNITED STATES ARMY EQUIPMENT AUTHORIZATIONS REVIEW CENTER. Effective 15 January 1963, the United States Army Equipment Authorizations Review Center located at Fort Belvoir, Va., is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General United States Army Materiel Command.

III. U.S. ARMY COMBAT SURVEILLANCE AGENCY. So much of Section I, DA General Orders 16, 1963, as reads "Effective 1 August 1962" is amended to read "Effective 15 October 1962."

IV. TRANSFER OF COMMAND OF U.S. ARMY STANDARDIZATION GROUPS. So much of Section III, DA General Orders 21, 1963, as reads "67-7859" is amended to read "69-7859" and so much as reads "67-7858" is amended to read "69-7858."

V. ROTC UNITS AT MILITARY SCHOOLS. In accordance with paragraph 9c(2), AR 145-25, ROTC units at the following named essentially military schools are designated as honor ROTC units for the school year 1962-63. This rating is effective only for academic year 1963-64:
