I..CAMP WOLTERS, TEXAS. *Effective 1 June 1963*, Camp Wolters, Texas, is redesignated Fort Wolters, Texas, and announced as a permanent Department of the Army installation.

II..UNITED STATES ARMY PROSTHETICS RESEARCH LABORATORY. *Effective 1 June 1963*, the United States Army Prosthetics Research Laboratory, Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington, D.C., a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is redesignated the United States Army Biomechanical Research Laboratory.

III..U.S. ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND ACTIVITIES. *Effective 1 May 1963*, the following class II activities located at Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, are discontinued and the associated functions, personnel, and equipment are consolidated with Edgewood Arsenal:

1. U.S. Army Chemical-Biological-Radiological Agency.
2. Chemical Research and Development Laboratories.
3. Edgewood Arsenal Activity.

IV..U.S. ARMY CHEMICAL CORPS ENGINEERING COMMAND. *Effective 1 September 1962*, the U.S. Army Chemical Corps Engineering Command, a class II activity at Edgewood Arsenal, Maryland, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued.

V..U.S. ARMY CHEMICAL CORPS RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT COMMAND. *Effective 1 September 1962*, the U.S. Army Chemical Corps Research and Development Command, a class II activity at Washington, D.C., under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued.

VI..NATIONAL BOARD FOR THE PROMOTION OF RIFLE PRACTICE. *Effective 15 July 1963*, Captain Edward P. Chester, Jr., USCG, is announced as a member of the National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice, representing the United States Coast Guard, vice Captain W. H. Buxton, USCG.
