I--GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, 5th Infantry Division (Mechanized) at Fort Carson, Fort Carson, Colorado, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 17 June 1963*.

II--DIAMOND ORDNANCE FUZE LABORATORIES, WASHINGTON, D.C. *Effective 13 November 1962*, the Diamond Ordnance Fuze Laboratories, Washington, D.C., a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated the Harry Diamond Laboratories.

III--QUARTERMASTER RESEARCH AND ENGINEERING CENTER, MASSACHUSETTS. *Effective 13 November 1962*, the Quartermaster Research and Engineering Center, Massachusetts, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated the Natick Laboratories.

IV--MAYNARD QUARTERMASTER TEST ACTIVITY, MASSACHUSETTS. *Effective 13 November 1962*, the Maynard Quartermaster Test Activity, Massachusetts, is consolidated with and designated as a part of Natick Laboratories, Massachusetts.
