Effective 8 January 1964, the U.S. Army Nuclear Weapon Systems Safety Group, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, is redesignated the U.S. Army Nuclear Weapon Systems Surety Group (SF-1800).

Effective 15 September 1963, the U.S. Army Production Equipment Storage Activity, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, and located at Lordstown Military Reservation, Ohio, is discontinued.
