I. UNITED STATES ARMY NUCLEAR WEAPON SYSTEMS SAFETY GROUP. *Effective 8 January 1964*, the U.S. Army Nuclear Weapon Systems Safety Group, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, is redesignated the U.S. Army Nuclear Weapon Systems Surety Group (SF-1800).

II. UNITED STATES ARMY PRODUCTION EQUIPMENT STORAGE ACTIVITY. *Effective 15 September 1963*, the U.S. Army Production Equipment Storage Activity, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, and located at Lords-town Military Reservation, Ohio, is discontinued.

III. U.S. ARMY PRIMARY FIXED WING SCHOOL, OLATHE, KANSAS. So much of Section III, General Orders Number 50, 1963, as reads "class II activity" is amended to read "class I activity".
