I.—DEFENSE INFORMATION SCHOOL. 1. *Effective 1 July 1964*, the Defense Information School (short title DINFOS) is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, at Fort Slocum, New York.

2. The Defense Information School will be administered by the Department of the Army in accordance with the authority and general policies set forth by the Department of Defense.

3. The mission of the Defense Information School is to provide information training for selected officers, enlisted personnel and civilian employees of Department of Defense components for information assignments at all levels of command throughout the Defense Establishment and to train a limited number of persons from other Federal agencies and foreign nations in the principles and techniques of United States Military information activities on a space available or reciprocal basis.

II.—U.S. ARMY INFORMATION SCHOOL. *Effective 30 June 1964*, the U.S. Army Information School at Fort Slocum, New York, an activity under the Commanding General, U.S. Continental Army Command, is discontinued.

III.—U.S. ARMY POLAR RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CENTER. *Effective 1 February 1964*, the U.S. Army Polar Research and Development Center, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, United States Army Materiel Command; and located at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Continental Army Command, is redesignated the U.S. Army Research Support Group.

IV.—U.S. ARMY PRIMARY FIXED WING SCHOOL, OLATHE, KANSAS. Section III, General Orders 54, 1963, as amended by Section III, General Orders 2, 1964, and Section IV, General Orders 5, 1964, is rescinded.
