I. FORT RITCHIE, MARYLAND. *Effective 1 April 1964,* Fort Ritchie, Maryland, a class I installation under the command of the Commanding General, Second U.S. Army, is transferred to the command of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Strategic Communications Command, and is designated a class II installation.

II. ARMY PICTORIAL CENTER, NEW YORK. *Effective 1 April 1964,* the Army Pictorial Center New York, a class II installation under command of the Chief of Communications-Electronics, is transferred to the Command of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command.

III. ROTC UNIT AT WORCESTER POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE, WORCESTER, MASSACHUSETTS. *Effective the second semester of the 1963-64 school year,* the Signal Corps branch materiel ROTC unit at Worcester Polytechnic Institute, Worcester, Massachusetts, is converted to a General Military Science ROTC unit.
