Effective 14 April 1964, the United States Army Security Agency is redesignated from an operating agency of Headquarters, Department of the Army to a major field command of the Department of the Army; and the Chief, United States Army Security Agency is redesignated Commanding General, United States Army Security Agency.
- II_WALTER REED ARMY INSTITUTE OF NURSING. Effective 1 May 1964, the Walter Reed Army Institute of Nursing is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington, D.C.
- III_UNITED STATES ARMY TROOP INFORMATION SUP-PORT UNIT (SF-3701), WASHINGTON, D.C. Effective 15 April 1964, the United States Army Troop Information Support Unit (SF-3701), a class II activity under the Chief of Information, is redesignated the United States Army Command Information Unit (SF-3701).
- IV_U.S. ARMY GENERAL EQUIPMENT TEST ACTIVITY. Effective 1 July 1964, the U.S. Army General Equipment Test Activity is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, at Fort Lee, Virginia.
- V_U.S. ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND ACTIVITIES. Effective 1 July 1964, the class II activities listed below, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, are discontinued. Functions, personnel, funds, records, and equipment are transferred to the U.S. Army General Equipment Test Activity, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, at Fort Lee Virginia.

 - 2. U.S. Army Transportation Board, Fort Eustis, Virginia.

- VI_CAMP LEROY JOHNSON, NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA. Effective 30 June 1964, Camp Leroy Johnson, New Orleans, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued as an Army installation.
