**I. U.S. ARMY SPECIAL WARFARE CENTER.** *Effective 1 June 1964*, the U.S. Army Special Warfare Center, a class I activity stationed at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, United States Continental Army Command, is redesignated the U.S. Army John F. Kennedy Center for Special Warfare, in honor of John F. Kennedy, the 35th President of the United States.

**II. UNITED STATES ARMY OPTICAL ACTIVITY.** *Effective 1 July 1964*, the United States Army Optical Activity is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, at Sharpe Army Depot, California.

**III. ROTC UNITS AT MILITARY SCHOOLS.** In accordance with paragraph 9c(2), AR 145-25, ROTC units at the following named essentially military schools are designated as honor ROTC units for the school year 1963-64. This rating is *effective only for academic year 1964-65*.
