**I..UNITED STATES ARMY DATA SERVICES AND ADMINIS-
TRATIVE SYSTEMS COMMAND, WASHINGTON, D.C.** *Effective 9
August 1964*, the United States Army Data Services and Administrative Sys-
tems Command, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant
General, is redesignated as the United States Army Data Support Command
(short title: USADATCOM).

**II..U.S. ARMY AIR DEFENSE ENGINEERING AGENCY, FORT
GEORGE G. MEADE, MARYLAND.** *Effective 1 July 1964*, the U.S. Army
Air Defense Engineering Agency, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of
the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command at Fort George G.
Meade, Maryland, is discontinued. Functions, personnel, records, and equip-
ment will be reassigned by the CG, USAMC.

**III..UNITED STATES ARMY MEDICAL SERVICE TEST AND
EVALUATION ACTIVITY.** *Effective 1 October 1964*, the United States
Army Medical Service Test and Evaluation Activity (short title: AMEDST&
EA) is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon
General, at Brooke Army Medical Center, Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

**IV..CLASS I ACTIVITIES ASSIGNED TO 21 ARMY COMMAND-
ERS.** Section III, General Orders 20, 1964, is amended to add the following
activity:

**V..JOINT ARMY-NAVY OCEAN TERMINAL, OAKLAND, CALI-
FORNIA.** *Effective 1 July 1964*, the Joint Army-Navy Ocean Terminal, a
joint service facility, is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction
of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, at the Oakland
Army Terminal, Oakland, California.

**VI..U.S. ARMY TRANSPORTATION AGENCY, WASHINGTON,
D.C. (WHITE HOUSE) (TC 7410).** *Effective 1 October 1964*, the U.S. Army
Transportation Agency, Washington, D.C. (White House) (TC 7410), a class
II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Transportation, is discon-
tinued. Concurrently, the U.S. Army Transportation Agency, Washington,
D.C. (White House) (MW 7050-01), is established as a class I activity under
the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Military District of Washington.

The mission, functions, personnel, funds, records, and/or equipment are transferred from the discontinued activity to the newly established activity.

VII.—ROTC UNITS AT MILITARY SCHOOLS. In accordance with paragraph 9c(2), AR 145-25, ROTC units at the following named essentially military schools are designated as honor ROTC units for the school year 1963-64: This designation of honor units is in addition to those announced in General Orders No. 19, dated 1 June 1964. This rating is effective only for academic year 1964-65:
