I.—JOLIET ARSENAL, ILLINOIS. *Effective 1 July 1964*, the Joliet Arsenal, Joliet, Illinois, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated the Joliet Army Ammunition Plant.

II.—LEXINGTON ARMY DEPOT, KENTUCKY. *Effective 1 August 1964*, the Lexington Army Depot, Lexington, Kentucky, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated the Lexington-Blue Grass Army Depot.

III.—BLUE GRASS ARMY DEPOT, KENTUCKY. *Effective 1 August 1964*, the Blue Grass Army Depot, Richmond, Kentucky, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated the Blue Grass Depot Activity of the Lexington-Blue Grass Army Depot.

IV.—WABASH RIVER ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT, INDIANA. *Effective 1 July 1964*, the Wabash River Army Ammunition Plant, Newport, Indiana, a class II inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated the Newport Army Ammunition Plant and placed in an active status.

V.—NEWPORT ARMY CHEMICALS PLANT, INDIANA. *Effective 1 July 1964*, the Newport Army Chemicals Plant, Newport, Indiana, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued. Functions, personnel, records, and equipment are assigned to the Newport Army Ammunition Plant, Newport, Indiana.

VI.—U.S. ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND ACTIVITIES. *Effective 1 July 1964*, the following class II activities under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, are discontinued. Their functions, personnel, records, and equipment will be assigned to directorates of the U.S. Army Electronics Command, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command:

1. U.S. Army Electronics Research Unit, Mountain View, California.
2. U.S. Army Liaison Group Project Michigan, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan.

VII. UNITS ENTITLED TO USAR AWARD, SECRETARY OF THE ARMY SUPERIOR UNIT CERTIFICATE. General Orders 8, 1964, is amended as follows:

Sixth United States Army

So much as reads "Transportation Staging Station (6194)" is changed to read "Transportation Staging Station (8694)."

VIII. UNITED STATES ARMY MEDICAL SERVICE TEST AND EVALUATION ACTIVITY. So much of section III, General Orders 26, 1964, as reads "*Effective 1 October 1964*," is amended to read "*Effective 1 October 1964*."

IX. SACRAMENTO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL, SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA. *Effective 1 August 1964*, the Junior Division ROTC unit at Sacramento Senior High School, Sacramento, California, is withdrawn.
