Permanent location will be Fort Benjamin Harrison, Ind., on or about 1 November 1964. Functions, personnel, and equipment are transferred from the Reserve Components Personnel Directorate to the U.S. Army Reserve Components Personnel Center.
- II\_SEATTLE ARMY CHEMICALS PLANT, WASHINGTON. Effective 1 July 1964, the Seattle Army Chemicals Plant was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
- III\_FORT DAWES, MASS. Effective 2 February 1963, Fort Dawes was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
- IV\_U.S. ARMY PHOTO INTERPRETATION CENTER, FORT HOLABIRD, MD. 1. Effective 15 October 1964, the U.S. Army Photo Interpretation Center (SF-1311-01), an activity of the U.S. Army Intelligence Corps Agency at Fort Holabird, Md., is discontinued.
