I. PHILADELPHIA PROCUREMENT DISTRICT, U.S. ARMY.

Effective 1 November 1964, the Philadelphia Procurement District, U.S. Army, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, and located at 128 North Broad Street, Philadelphia, Pa., is discontinued.
