I.—DIRECTORATE OF TRANSPORTATION. 1. *Effective 15 December 1964*, the Directorate of Transportation is established in the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics.

2. The Directorate of Transportation will be organized and staffed under the same organizational and TD structure as that approved for the Office of the Chief of Transportation as of 15 December 1964, and will be physically located in the same space as that occupied by the former Office of the Chief of Transportation.

3. Incumbent personnel will continue to perform the same duties as those performed in the Office of the Chief of Transportation.

II.—OFFICE OF THE CHIEF OF TRANSPORTATION. *Effective 15 December 1964*, the Office of the Chief of Transportation is discontinued and all of its assigned functions, personnel, funds, records, and equipment are transferred to the DCSLOG Directorate of Transportation.

III.—DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY AWARDS FOR SAFETY. Under the provisions of paragraph 16, AR 385-10, the following organizations are awarded Department of the Army Awards for Safety for fiscal year 1964:

1. Award of Honor for Safety
 - U.S. Army Forces Southern Command
 - 2d U.S. Army
 - 2d Infantry Division
 - 7th Infantry Division
2. Award of Merit for Safety
 - U.S. Army, Pacific
 - 4th U.S. Army
 - Chief of Engineers
 - The Surgeon General
 - 1st Cavalry Division

IV.—LOUISVILLE ARMY DEPOT, KENTUCKY. *Effective 1 October 1964*, the Louisville Army Depot was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
