- I\_\_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, Fort Buckner, Okinawa, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial, effective 1 February 1965.
- II\_FORT WILLIAMS, MAINE. Effective 27 November 1964, Fort Williams was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
- III\_CHICAGO ORDNANCE PLANT, ILL. Effective 13 October 1964, the Chicago Ordnance Plant was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
- IV\_LAWNDALE ARMY MISSILE PLANT, LAWNDALE, CALIF. Effective 23 October 1964, the Lawndale Army Missile Plant is established as a class II active installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command.
- V\_EAST COAST MINOR RELAY STATION. Effective 1 February 1965, the East Coast Minor Relay Station at Fort Lee, Va., a class II activity assigned to the U.S. Army Strategic Communications Command, is discontinued.
- VI\_GRAND BLANC STORAGE FACILITY NO. 2, MICH. So much of section III, General Orders 42, 1964, as reads "Grand Blanc Storage Facility No. 2, California" is amended to read "Grand Blanc Storage Facility No. 2, Michigan."
