I--HEADQUARTERS, FIRST U.S. ARMY. *Effective 1 January 1966*, Headquarters, First U.S. Army, less personnel and equipment, is transferred from Governors Island, N.Y., to Fort George G. Meade, Md. Personnel and equipment determined to be surplus as a result of this action will be reassigned or disposed of in accordance with applicable directives.

II--HEADQUARTERS, SECOND U.S. ARMY. *Effective 1 January 1966*, Headquarters, Second U.S. Army, Fort George G. Meade, Md., is inactivated. Its missions, functions, organization, installations, activities, personnel, records, and equipment are concurrently reassigned or transferred, as appropriate, to the command jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First U.S. Army.
