## HEADQUARTERS DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON, D.C., 22 April 1965

- I\_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. - IV\_U.S. ARMY PRODUCTION EQUIPMENT STORAGE ACTIVITY, FORT CUSTER, MICH. Effective 1 July 1965, the U.S. Army Production Equipment Storage Activity, Fort Custer, Mich., a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued.
- V\_BENICIA ARSENAL, CALIF. Effective 26 February 1965, Benicia Arsenal, Calif., was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
- VI\_KEYSTONE ORDNANCE WORKS, PA. Effective 24 March 1965, Keystone Ordnance Works, Pa., was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.
