- I_RESPONSIBILITY FOR CIVILIAN PERSONNEL MANAGE-MENT IN THE ARMY ESTABLISHMENT. Paragraph 3, General Orders 32, 1956, is amended as follows:
 - 3. Delegation of authority.
- h. The Commanding General, U.S. Continental Army Command, for headquarters and field activities under his direction and control, and the Commanding Generals of the ZI Armies and the Military District of Washington, through the Commanding General, U.S. Continental Army Command, for organizations and activities under their direction and control.
 - i. Rescinded.
- II_UNITED STATES ARMY INFORMATION AND DATA SYSTEMS COMMAND. Effective 1 June 1965, the United States Army Information and Data Systems Command (short title: USAIDSCOM) is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Office, Chief of Staff, United States Army.
- III_SAGINAW ARMY AIRCRAFT PLANT, SAGINAW, TEXAS. Effective 31 March 1965, the Saginaw Army Aircraft Plant is established as a class II active installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command.
- IV__UNITED STATES ARMY OFFICER EVALUATION CENTER, FORT McCLELLAN, ALABAMA. Effective 1 July 1965, the United States Army Officer Evaluation Center (SF-2912), a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Personnel Operations, is discontinued.
- V__UNITS ENTITLED TO USAR AWARD—SECRETARY OF THE ARMY SUPERIOR UNIT CERTIFICATE. General Orders 7, 1965, is amended as follows:
 - 1. Fifth United States Army. Add the following unit:
