I_MILITARY OCEAN TERMINAL, BAYONNE. Effective 1 July 1965, the Military Ocean Terminal, Bayonne, is established at the Navy Supply Center, Bayonne, N.J., as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service.

II_U.S. ARMY TERMINAL COMMAND, GULF. Effective 1 July 1965, the U.S. Army Terminal Command, Gulf, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service, is discontinued and its functions, personnel, equipment, and records transferred to the Commander, Eastern Area, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service.

III_NEW ORLEANS ARMY TERMINAL. Effective 1 July 1965, the New Orleans Army Terminal, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service, is

discontinued. IV_HAMPTON ROADS ARMY TERMINAL. Effective 1 July 1965, the Hampton Roads Army Terminal, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service, is

discontinued. V_MILITARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND TERMINAL SERVICE INSTALLATIONS. 1. Effective 1 July 1965, the Joint Army-Navy Ocean Terminal, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service, is redesignated as the Military Ocean Terminal, Bay Area.

2. Effective 1 July 1965, the Oakland Army Terminal, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and

Terminal Service, is redesignated as the Oakland Army Base.

3. Effective 1 July 1965, the following class II installations under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service,

a. Brooklyn Army Terminal redesignated as Military Ocean Terminal, are redesignated:

Brooklyn.

b. Sunny Point Army Terminal redesignated as Military Ocean Terminal,

c. King's Bay Army Terminal redesignated as Military Ocean Terminal, Sunny Point. King's Bay.
