- I_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding officer, Seventh Army Support Command, APO New York, 09160, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial, effective 22 June 1965.
