Effective 1 August 1965, Fort Wadsworth, New York, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First United States Army, is redesignated as a class I subinstallation of Fort Hamilton, New York, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First United States Army.
- II_U.S. ARMY ENGINEER PROCUREMENT OFFICE, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS. Effective 31 October 1965, the U.S. Army Engineer Procurement Office, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued.
