**I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL.** The Commanding Officer, Field Force, Vietnam, APO San Francisco 96240, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 16 November 1965*.

**II. WEST POINT MILITARY RESERVATION.** *Effective 22 November 1965*, the West Point Military Reservation, West Point, New York, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Assistance Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

**III. UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY.** *Effective 22 November 1965*, the United States Military Academy, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Deputy chief of Staff for Personnel, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

**IV. UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY PREPARATORY SCHOOL.** *Effective 22 November 1965*, the United States Military Academy Preparatory School, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

**V. UNITED STATES ARMY WAR COLLEGE.** *Effective 22 November 1965*, the United States Army War College, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

**VI. DEFENSE INFORMATION SCHOOL.** *Effective 22 November 1965*, the Defense Information School, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

**VII. DEFENSE LANGUAGE INSTITUTE.** *Effective 22 November 1965*, the Defense Language Institute, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, Headquarters, Department of the Army.

**VIII. MILITARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND TERMINAL SERVICE TRAFFIC REGIONS.** 1. *Effective 1 March 1966*, the following traffic regions, class II activities under the jurisdiction of the Commander, MTMTS, are discontinued and their functions, personnel, personnel spaces, files, records and office equipment, where applicable, are transferred to the jurisdiction of the area commanders shown with stations as indicated:

Southeastern Traffic Region, Forest Park, Ga.	Commander, Eastern Area, MTMTS, Brooklyn, N.Y.

2. *Effective 1 June 1966*, the Southwestern Traffic Region, Dallas, Texas, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commander, MTMTS, is discontinued and its functions, personnel, personnel spaces, files, records, and office equipment, where applicable, transferred to the jurisdiction of the Commander, Central Area, MTMTS, St. Louis, Mo.

3. The discontinuances and transfers will be accomplished under time-phase plans and schedules developed by the commanders concerned and approved by the Commander, MTMTS.

**IX. DEFENSE INFORMATION SCHOOL.** *Effective 1 November 1965*, the Defense Information School, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Force Development, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is relocated from Fort Slocum, New York, to Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana.
