- I_U.S. ARMY CONSOLIDATED HOUSEHOLD GOODS SHIPPING OFFICE FOR THE ARMED FORCES, WASHINGTON, D.C. Effective 1 March 1966, the U.S. Army Consolidated Household Goods Shipping Office for the Armed Forces, located at Washington, D.C. (Cameron Station), a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Military District of Washington, is redesignated as the Joint Household Goods Shipping Office, Washington, D.C.
- II_U.S. ARMY SUBSISTENCE CENTER, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS. Effective 1 January 1966, the U.S. Army Subsistence Center, Chicago, Illinois, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Support Services, Headquarters, Department of the Army, is redesignated the U.S. Army Food Service Center.
- III...U.S. ARMY ORDNANCE GUIDED MISSILE SCHOOL, RED-STONE ARSENAL, ALABAMA. Effective 1 January 1966, the U.S. Army Ordnance Guided Missile School, a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, United States Continental Army Command, is redesignated as the U.S. Army Missile and Munitions Center and School.
- IV__CINCINNATI PROCUREMENT DISTRICT, U.S. ARMY. So much of section V, General Orders 36, 28 October 1965, as reads "1367 East 6th Street Cleveland, Ohio" is amended to read "550 Main Street, Cincinnati, Ohio."
- V_ROTC UNIT AT INDIANA STATE COLLEGE, INDIANA, PENNSYLVANIA. Effective the beginning of the 1966-67 school year, the Quartermaster Branch Material ROTC unit at Indiana State College, Indiana, Pennsylvania, is converted to a General Military Science ROTC unit.
- VI_U.S. ARMY MILITARY POLICE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION REPOSITORY (USAMPCIR), FORT HOLABIRD, MARYLAND. Effective 1 January 1966, the U.S. Army Military Police Criminal Investigation Repository (USAMPCIR), Fort Holabird, Maryland, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Provost Marshall General, is discontinued. Concurrently, the functions of the USAMPCIR are transferred to the control of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Intelligence Command, and will be integrated with the U.S. Army Counterintelligence Records Facility (USACRF) at Fort Holabird, Maryland.
