I. BADGER ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT. *Effective 23 December 1965*, the Badger Army Ammunition Plant, Baraboo, Wis., a class II inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is placed in an active status.

II. ST. LOUIS ORDNANCE PLANT, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI. *Effective 1 March 1966*, the St. Louis Ordnance Plant, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated as the St. Louis Army Ammunition Plant.

III. U.S. ARMY PERSONNEL CENTER, FORT LEWIS, WASHINGTON. So much of General Orders 11, 1966, as reads "U.S. ARMY PERSONNEL CENTER, FORT LEWIS, WASHINGTON (UIC-W12G)" is amended to read "U.S. ARMY PERSONNEL CENTER, FORT LEWIS, WASHINGTON (UIC-W1ZG)".
