III--U.S. ARMY TRAINING CENTER, FORT LEWIS, WASHINGTON. *Effective 2 May 1966*, the United States Army Training Center, Infantry (UIC: W12K), is established at Fort Lewis, Washington, as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth United States Army.

IV--U.S. ARMY RECEPTION STATION, FORT BRAGG, NORTH CAROLINA. *Effective 2 May 1966*, the United States Army Reception Station (UIC: W0U3), is established at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third United States Army.

V--U.S. ARMY RECEPTION STATION, FORT CAMPBELL, KENTUCKY. *Effective 2 May 1966*, the United States Army Reception Station (UIC: W0U4), is established at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third United States Army.

VI--U.S. ARMY RECEPTION STATION, FORT LEWIS, WASHINGTON. *Effective 2 May 1966*, the United States Army Reception Station (UIC: W12G), is established at Fort Lewis, Washington, as an activity of the United States Army Personnel Center, Fort Lewis, Washington, a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth United States Army.
