I.—FORT CROWDER, MO. *Effective 23 March 1965*, Fort Crowder, Mo., a class I inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fifth U.S. Army, was discontinued.

II.—CAMP LUCAS, MICH. *Effective 11 April 1966*, Camp Lucas, Mich., a class I inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fifth U.S. Army, was discontinued.

III.—BEAVER ARMY TERMINAL, OREG. *Effective 31 March 1966*, Beaver Army Terminal, Oreg., a class II inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, was discontinued.

IV.—FORT MASON, CALIF. *Effective 30 June 1966*, Fort Mason, Calif., a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service, is placed in an inactive status.

V.—U.S. ARMY COURIER TRANSFER STATION, CHATEAUROUX, FRANCE. *Effective 12 September 1966*, the U.S. Army Courier Transfer Station, Chateauroux, TD No. AG 4001 2F, a subordinate activity of the U.S. Army Courier Service Headquarters, is discontinued.

VI.—U.S. ARMY MEDICAL RESEARCH UNIT, PRESIDIO OF SAN FRANCISCO. *Effective 1 September 1966*, the U.S. Army Medical Research Unit, Presidio of San Francisco, is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, at the Presidio of San Francisco, San Francisco, Calif.
