- I_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Aviation Materiel Command, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, effective 10 November 1966.
- II_U.S. ARMY NIKE-X ENGINEERING/SERVICE TEST OF-FICE. 1. Effective 15 November 1966, the U.S. Army NIKE-X Engineering/ Service Test Office (ESTO) with station at White Sands Missile Range, N. Mex., is established as a class II activity under the command of the U.S. Army Materiel Command, and effective concurrently is placed under the operational control of the NIKE-X System Manager.
- 2. The ESTO is established to provide a single organization for performing evaluation of the NIKE-X System independent of the NIKE-X Project Office and its NIKE-X contractors. The mission of ESTO includes the responsibility for performing or participating in testing necessary to support independent system evaluation and insuring that the test and independent evaluation program is responsive to user requirements.
- III_FORT LINCOLN, NORTH DAKOTA. Effective 7 September 1966, Fort Lincoln, N. Dak., a class I inactive installation under the jurisdiction of Commanding General, Fifth U.S. Army, was discontinued.
- IV_DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY AWARDS FOR SAFETY. Under the provisions of paragraph 16, AR 385-10, Department of the Army Awards for Safety for fiscal year 1966 are given to major commands and U.S. armies listed below. Safety awards for Army divisions will be announced subsequently. Award winners are selected on the basis of achievement of criteria standards specified in appendix I, AR 385-10.
