U.S. ARMY FIELD OPERATING COST AGENCY—Established

- I_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Training Center, Fort Jackson, South Carolina 29207, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, effective 1 January 1967.
- II_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Engineer Command, Vietnam (Provisional), APO San Francisco 96307, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial, effective 14 January 1967.
- III__U.S. ARMY FIELD OPERATING COST AGENCY. 1. Effective 1 December 1966, the U.S. Army Field Operating Cost Agency is established at Washington, D.C., as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Comptroller of the Army.
- 2. The mission of the U.S. Army Field Operating Cost Agency is to perform special cost analysis studies of field operating activities and functions Army-wide as directed by the Comptroller of the Army.
