U.S. Army Reception Station (UIC:WOM 6) (previously organized).

II_U.S. ARMY COURIER STATION, AMADOR. Effective 1 March 1967, the U.S. Army Courier Station, Amador, a subordinate activity of the U.S. Army Courier Service, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant General, is redesignated U.S. Army Courier Station, Panama. The U.S. Army Courier Station, Panama, is located at Howard Air Force Base, C.Z.
