- I_OFFICE OF THE ASSISTANT VICE CHIEF OF STAFF, U.S. ARMY. Effective 16 February 1967, the Office of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff, U.S. Army is established in the Office of the Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.
- II_OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF STUDIES. Effective 22 March 1967, the Office of the Director of Studies is established in the Office of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.
- III_OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEMS. Effective 22 March 1967, the Office of Director of Management Information Systems is established in the Office of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.
- IV...OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF FORCE PLANNING ANALYSIS. Effective 20 February 1967, the Office of the Director of Force Planning Analysis is established in the Office of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.
- V_OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF WEAPON SYSTEMS ANALY-SIS. Effective 20 February 1967, the Office of the Director of Weapon Systems Analysis is established in the office of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.
- VI_-OFFICE OF SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE CHIEF OF STAFF FOR ARMY INFORMATION AND DATA SYSTEMS. Effective 22 March 1967, the Office of Special Assistant to the Chief of Staff for Army Information and Data Systems is discontinued as an element of the Office of the Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.
- VII_FORCE PLANNING AND ANALYSIS OFFICE. Effective 20 February 1967, the Force Planning and Analysis Office is discontinued as an element of the Office of the Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.

- VIII_UNITED STATES ARMY INFORMATION AND DATA SYSTEMS COMMAND. Effective 1 April 1967, the United States Army Information and Data Systems Command (AIDSCOM), a class II activity formerly under the jurisdiction of the Special Assistant for Army Information and Data Systems, Office, Chief of Staff, U.S. Army, is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Comptroller of the Army.
- IX._UNITED STATES ARMY MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS SUP-PORT AGENCY. Effective 1 April 1967, the United States Army Management Systems Support Agency (AMSSA), is established at Washington, D.C., as a class II activity of the Office, Chief of Staff, under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Vice Chief of Staff, U.S. Army.
- X__CENTRAL AREA, MILITARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND TERMINAL SERVICE. Effective 1 April 1967, the Central Area, MTMTS, a major subordinate command of the Military Traffic Management and Terminal Service, with headquarters at St. Louis, Missouri, is discontinued and its functions, personnel, resources, records, and equipment are transferred to the jurisdiction of the Commander, Eastern Area, MTMTS.
- XI_ST. LOUIS FIELD OFFICE, EASTERN AREA, MTMTS. Effective 1 April 1967, the St. Louis Field Office, Eastern Area, MTMTS, St. Louis, Missouri, is established as a class II activity of the MTMTS and placed under the jurisdiction of the Commander, Eastern Area, MTMTS.
- XII_JUNIOR ROTC SUBUNITS AT MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE. The Junior ROTC subunit at Humes High School will be withdrawn and transferred to Northside High School, effective 1 July 1967.
