- I_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, Fort Campbell, Kentucky, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial, effective 18 August 1967.
- II_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. Effective 14 August 1967, the following persons under the jurisdiction of the Department of the Army who are subject to the Uniform Code of Military Justice are attached to the Military District of Washington, U.S. Army, for all matters pertaining to the administration of military justice, including general court-martial jurisdiction, regardless of whether the installations or activities at which such persons are stationed or with which they are on duty are under the command of the Commanding Officer, Military District of Washington, U.S. Army:
- 1. Department of the Army personnel stationed within the geographic area of the Military District of Washington, U.S. Army, and not under the command of any other officer authorized to convene general courts-martial.
- 2. Department of the Army attaché personnel assigned to the U.S. Army Element DIA (SD-5825-OF), Defense Attaché System and Department of the Army personnel attached to Defense attaché offices for administrative support and services.
- 3. Department of the Army personnel assigned to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.
- III_FORT TOTTEN, NEW YORK. Effective 31 July 1967, Fort Totten, New York, a class I subinstallation of Fort Hamilton, New York, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First United States Army, is placed in an inactive status.
- IV_U.S. ARMY ENGINEER RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT LABORATORIES. Effective 1 September 1967, the U.S. Army Engineer Research and Development Laboratories, Fort Belvoir, Virginia, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is redesignated the U.S. Army Mobility Equipment Research and Development Center.
