I. CHARLOTTE ARMY MISSILE PLANT, NORTH CAROLINA.

Effective 1 September 1967, Charlotte Army Missile Plant, North Carolina, a class II inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, is discontinued as a Department of the Army installation.

II. WARRIOR OF THE PACIFIC TEAM COMPETITION. 1. In accordance with paragraph 8, AR 145-395, the annual Warrior of the Pacific rifle competition was conducted at General Military Science ROTC training camps. Dartmouth College, Hanover, New Hampshire 03755, is announced as the winner of the Warrior of the Pacific trophy for the year 1967. Average score per man was 52.68.

2. The Commanding General, Sixth United States Army will make necessary arrangements for shipping the Warrior of the Pacific trophy, now in the possession of Washington State University, Pullman, Washington.

III. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. Effective 4 October 1967, a class MI Junior ROTC unit is reinstated at Fishburne Military School, Waynesboro, Virginia, under the provisions of AR 145-10.

2. So much of section III, DA General Orders 37, 15 September 1967, as pertains to the establishment of a class HS Junior ROTC unit at Barstow High School, Barstow, California, is rescinded.

3. In accordance with paragraph 9c(2), AR 145-25, ROTC units at the following named essentially military schools are designated as honor ROTC units for the school year 1966-67. This designation of honor units is in addition to those announced in DA General Orders 25, 16 June 1967 and DA General Orders 29, 6 July 1967. This rating is effective only for academic year 1967-68:

Missouri Military School, Mexico, Missouri
Onarga Military School, Onarga, Illinois
Riverside Military Academy, Gainesville, Georgia
Roosevelt Military Academy, Aledo, Illinois

Wentworth Military Academy, Lexington, Missouri
Western Military Academy, Alton, Illinois
