I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, United States Army Aviation Center and Fort Rucker, Fort Rucker, Alabama, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 1 December 1967*.

II. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, United States Army Training Center, Infantry and Fort Polk, Fort Polk, Louisiana, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 1 January 1968*.

III. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, United States Army Air Defense Center and Fort Bliss, Fort Bliss, Texas, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 1 January 1968*.

IV. UNITED STATES ARMY CORRECTIONAL TRAINING FACILITY. *Effective 1 January 1968*, the United States Army Correctional Training Facility is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Provost Marshal General, at Camp Funston area, Fort Riley, Kansas.
