I--GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Artillery and Missile Center and Fort Sill, Fort Sill, Okla., is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial *effective 19 January 1968*.

II--GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Training Center, Infantry and Fort Lewis (Provisional), Fort Lewis, Wash., is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial *effective 24 January 1968*.

III--U.S. ARMY LOGISTICS DOCTRINE AND SYSTEMS AGENCY, NEW CUMBERLAND ARMY DEPOT, PENNSYLVANIA. *Effective 1 February 1968*, the U.S. Army Logistics Doctrine and Systems Agency, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics, located at New Cumberland Army Depot, Post Office Box 2947, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17105, is redesignated the U.S. Army Logistics Doctrine, Systems and Readiness Agency.
