I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, Eighth Field Army Support Command, APO San Francisco 96301, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to Article 22(a)(6), Uniform Code of Military Justice, to convene general courts-martial, *effective 1 March 1968*.

II. NATIONAL BOARD FOR THE PROMOTION OF RIFLE PRACTICE. General Orders 39, 1967, is amended as follows:

1. *Effective 19 February 1968*, Brigadier General Robert G. Owens, Jr., USMC, Assistant Chief of Staff, G-3, United States Marine Corps, is appointed to membership on the National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice, to serve the unexpired term of Major General Herman Nickerson, Jr., USMC.

2. *Effective 19 February 1968*, Lieutenant Colonel Sidney R. Hinds, Jr., GS, USA, is appointed Executive Officer of the National Board for the Promotion of Rifle Practice vice Lieutenant Colonel Joseph B. Berry.

III. JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. *Effective 1 April 1968*, class HS Junior ROTC units are established at the following institutions under the provisions of AR 145-10:

Lawton Senior High School, Lawton, Oklahoma
