I_ARMY MEDICAL SERVICE. Pursuant to Public Law 90-329, the Army Medical Service is redesignated the Army Medical Department, effective 4 June 1968.

II_DESERET TEST CENTER, UTAH. Effective 1 July 1968, chemical-biological field test activities located at Dugway Proving Ground, Utah, a class II installation, are combined with the Deseret Test Center, a class II activity located in Salt Lake City, Utah. The combined organization is designated the Deseret Test Center, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, U.S. Army Materiel Command, with headquarters at Salt Lake City, Utah and elements at Dugway Proving Ground, Utah.

III_UNITED STATES DISCIPLINARY BARRACKS. Effective 1 July 1968, the United States Disciplinary Barracks, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, is discontinued as a class I activity under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General Fifth United States Army, and established at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Provost Marshal General, Headquarters, Department of the Army.
