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**I. FORT CUSTER, MICH.** Effective 30 June 1968, Fort Custer, Mich., was discontinued as a Department of the Army installation. The retained portion is designated the Custer Reserve Forces Training Area.

**II. FORT HAYES, OHIO.** Effective 1 July 1968, Fort Hayes, Ohio, a class I inactive installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First United States Army, is designated a subinstallation of Fort Knox, Ky.

**III. PRESIDENTIAL UNIT CITATION.** So much of section II, DA General Orders 30, 1968, as pertains to the award of the Presidential Unit Citation to the Twenty-Sixth Marines (Reinforced), Third Marine Division (Reinforced) is amended to add the following attached Army units: *amended GO 17 '69*
