I_GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding General, United States Army Training Center and Fort Campbell (Provisional), Fort Campbell, Kentucky, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a)(6), to convene general courts-martial effective 28 August 1969.

II_ARMY MAP SERVICE. Effective 1 August 1969, the Army Map Service, Brookmont, Maryland, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Engineers, is redesignated the Army Topographic Station.

III_JUNIOR ROTC UNITS. 1. Effective 1 September 1969, class HS Junior ROTC units were established at the following institutions under the provisions of AR 145-10 with training to commence September 1969.

Theodore High School, Theodore, Alabama Greenwood High School, Greenwood, South Carolina Elbert County High School, Elberton, Georgia

Effective 1 September 1969, a class HS Junior ROTC unit is established at Olympic Senior High School, Charlotte, North Carolina, under the provisions of AR 145-10 with training to commence September 1969. The ROTC unit is transferred from South Mecklenburg High School, Pineville, North Carolina.
 So much of DA General Orders 29, 1 May 1969, as pertains to the establishment of a class HS Junior ROTC unit at Project 1 Senior High School, San Antonio, Texas, is rescinded effective 1 September 1969.
