During the period 1 March 1968 to 31 May 1969, the 2d Civil Affairs Company provided outstanding support for military operations in the III Corps Tactical Zone. Following the 1968 TET Offensive, this company deployed throughout each province of the III Corps Tactical Zone rendering assistance to province chiefs in connection with pacification and development programs. The company aided in the reconstruction of facilities and dwellings destroyed in battle and provided foodstuffs, medicines and materials to the populace. By these activities, the 2d Civil Affairs Company fostered good relations between the Vietnamese people and the United States Army.
